

God is Faithful

Genesis 41:32

And for that the dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; it is because the thing is established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass.

Genesis 45:4-8

And Joseph said unto his brethren, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I am Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt. 5 Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life. 6 For these two years hath the famine been in the land: and yet there are five years, in the which there shall neither be earing nor harvest. 7 And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance. 8 So now it was not you that sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.

Genesis 50:20

But as for you, ye thought evil against me; but God meant it (the vision) unto good, to bring to pass, as it is this day, to save much people alive.

The vision is for an anointed time and in the end, the vision shall speak. God gave Joseph the vision with a 3-fold:

1. Purpose 1 preserve life
2. Purpose 2 preserve a remnant/posterity
3. Purpose 3 to save lives by a great deliverance.

A Song or Psalm for the sons of Korah, to the chief Musician upon Mahalath Leannoth, Maschil of Heman the Ezrahite.

Here, we see the Psalmist calling on the faithfulness of God.

Genesis 3:6-10

And when the woman saw (looking & reasoning got her out of faith/trusting in God) that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. 7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. 8 And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden. 9 And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? 10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

Adam was unfaithful to God and immediately, it gave place to fear. Fear empowers the enemy to manifest his desires of evil.

John 10:10-11

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. 11 I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.

Gen 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

God was coming to prove him to be a faithful steward.

Luke 12:39-44

And this know, that if the goodman of the house had known what hour the thief would come, he would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through. 40 Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.

41 Then Peter said unto him, Lord, speakest thou this parable unto us, or even to all? 42 And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? 43 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. 44 Of a truth I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.

Faithfulness is the key to promotion. We have to pass the test of obedience.

Was Adam faithful in that which is least?

6 Thou hast laid me in the lowest pit (abyss),
in darkness, in the deeps.

Psalms 89:1-8

with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.

2 For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever:
thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.

3 I have made a covenant with my chosen,
I have sworn unto David my servant,

4 Thy seed will I establish for ever,
and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah.

5 And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O Lord:
thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints.
