

Palm Sunday 2020

John 12:12-19

The last three days of Jesus' earthly ministry

Nisan 11 is Palm Sunday

This week in 2020 mirrors the week that Jesus died

Jewish day as given in Genesis 1:5, "And the evening and the morning were the first day"

The last week of Jesus begins at the house of Zacchaeus. And he gets saved, so to speak...

John 13: The last supper and the last of Jesus life begins with that meal at the beginning of the day - Nisan 14, which is Wednesday (Tuesday at sundown).

- Washes the disciples feet
- Foretells his betrayal:
 - John 13:26-27
Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. 27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus unto him, That thou doest, do quickly.
- Gives them a new commandment to love one another as He loved them (John 13:34)
- Don't let your heart be troubled, you believe in God, believe in me; in my Father's house are many mansions...

- John 14 he prepares them to receive the ministry of Holy Spirit
- John 15 “I am the vine and you are the branches...”
 - If you love me, keep my commandments...
- John 16 More on the ministry of Holy Spirit
- John 16:33

These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
- John 16, the Lord’s prayer...
 - Part of it: John 17:21-23

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. 22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.
- John 18 He is arrested

Jesus comes to Jerusalem for Pesah

- Pesah is Hebrew for Passover
- Luke 22:15 “And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer.”
- Exodus 23:14 Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year.
 - Jews call this **Shalosh Regalim**:
 1. Unleavened Bread (Passover and firstfruits)
 2. Shavuot (Feast of weeks (Pentecost))
 3. Sukkot (tabernacles/booths)

Jesus is arriving in Jerusalem to be the Passover sacrifice

Exodus 11

Exodus 12:1-7

- Proverbs 28:10 Whoso causeth the righteous to go astray in an evil way, he shall fall himself into his own pit: but the upright shall have good things in possession.
- Psalms 58:11 So that a man shall say, Verily there is a reward for the righteous: verily he is a God that judgeth in the earth.

Exodus 12:8-14

Hebrews 11:28

Through faith he (Moses) kept the Passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

Hebrews 11:28 (NLT)

It was by faith that Moses commanded the people of Israel to keep the Passover and to sprinkle blood on the doorposts so that the angel of death would not kill their firstborn sons.

Hebrews 13:12

Wherefore Jesus also, that he might sanctify the people with his own blood, suffered without the gate.

Hebrews 13:12 (GW)

That is why Jesus suffered outside the gates of Jerusalem. He suffered to make the people holy with his own blood.

Hebrews 13:20-21

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Hebrews 13:20-21 (NLT)

Now may the God of peace — who brought up from the dead our Lord Jesus, the great Shepherd of the sheep, and ratified an eternal covenant with his blood — 21 may he equip you with all you need for doing his will. May he produce in you, through the power of Jesus Christ, every good thing that is pleasing to him. All glory to him forever and ever! Amen.

3 Days & 3 Nights

Matthew 12:38-40

Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee. 39 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas: 40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
